
#### **Collect the Entire Series**

### Collect the entire Valentine Bingo Series








- **Pictures** Best for younger kids. Sign the words.
- **Fingerspelling** Say, sign, or fingerspelling the words.
- Sign- Say, sign, fingerspell, or hold up objects of the words.







#### What You'll Need:

- Bingo Cards
- Candy Heart Token Sheets
- Scissors
- Storage for Bingo pieces

#### Assembly:

- Print bingo cards on cardstock (The 12 cards are numbered on top left)
- Cut out the candy heart tokens
- Optional: laminate to prolong card life


**Directions:** Provide each student with a bingo card and tokens. Call out a word, sign, or fingerspell from the calling card. Students that have the matching word can cover the square with a token. Once a student has four squares in a row covered (horizontally, vertically or diagonally) they may call out "BINGO". The first student to reach Bingo wins. Continue to play for second and third place or start over. NOTE: Each set in the series has 12 cards. Each card number matches across the series so you can mix up the series for a variety of fun.

**Fun Tips:** Play Bingo with different winning patterns pictured below. Play with real candy hearts that the students can eat after they BINGO. Mix and use cards from the four different sets (English, pictures, fingerspelling, signs).
