



Level: K-1


Category: Shapes Book

Directions: Students follow directions on each worksheet.




Craft: Cut a large pentagon shape into smaller pieces to create a puzzle.


Game: Hide pentagon-shaped objects around the room for children to find and collect in a basket.


Idea: Build with pentagons using wooden or plastic blocks that include pentagons shapes.


