**Level:** Pre-K, K, 1

**Topics:** Physical Education, Exercise, Health

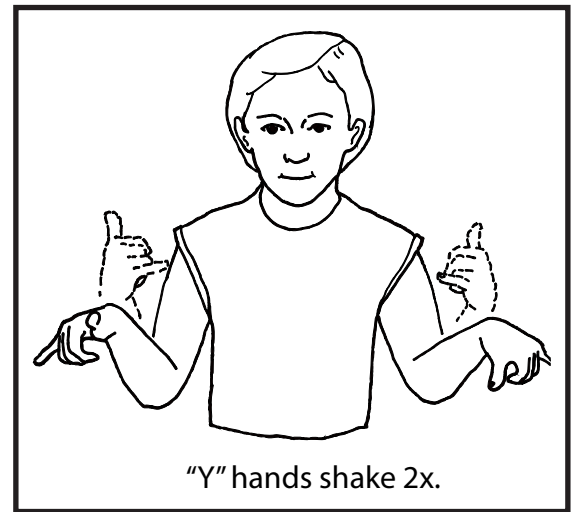
**Materials:** coloring utensils, paper, printed keyboard, pencil
