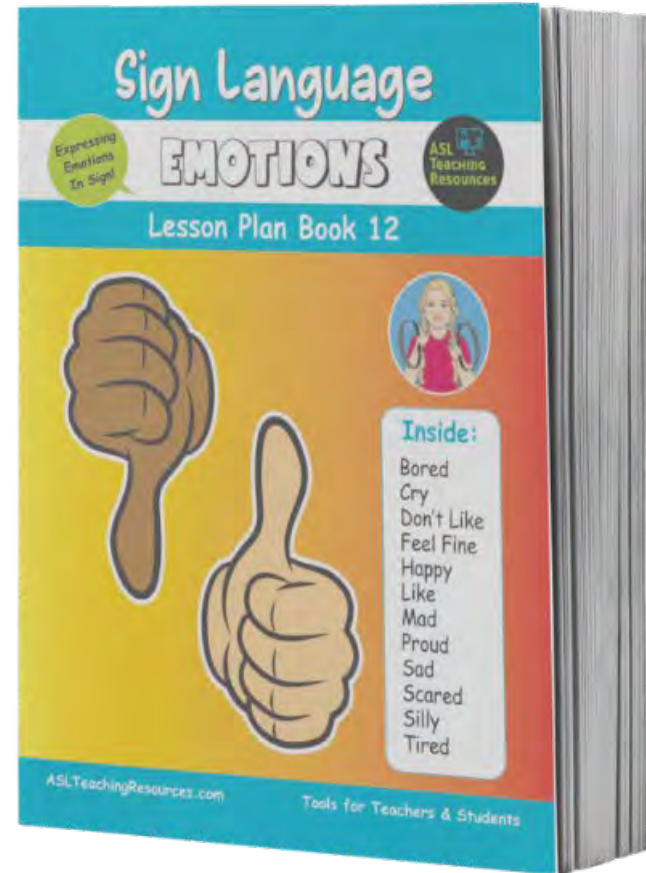


Sentence Structure
