

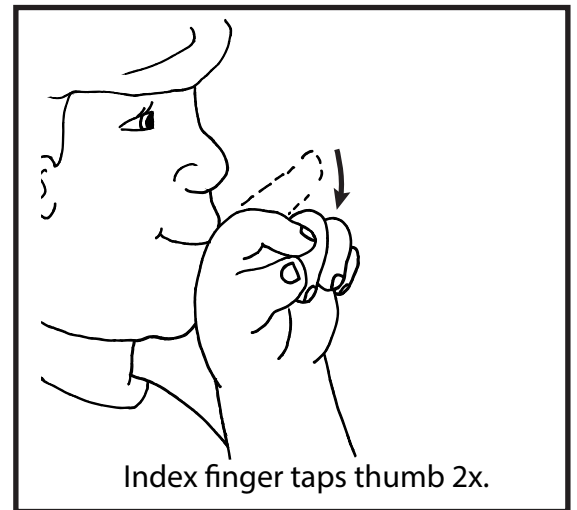

Materials: coloring utensils, paper, string, gummy worms



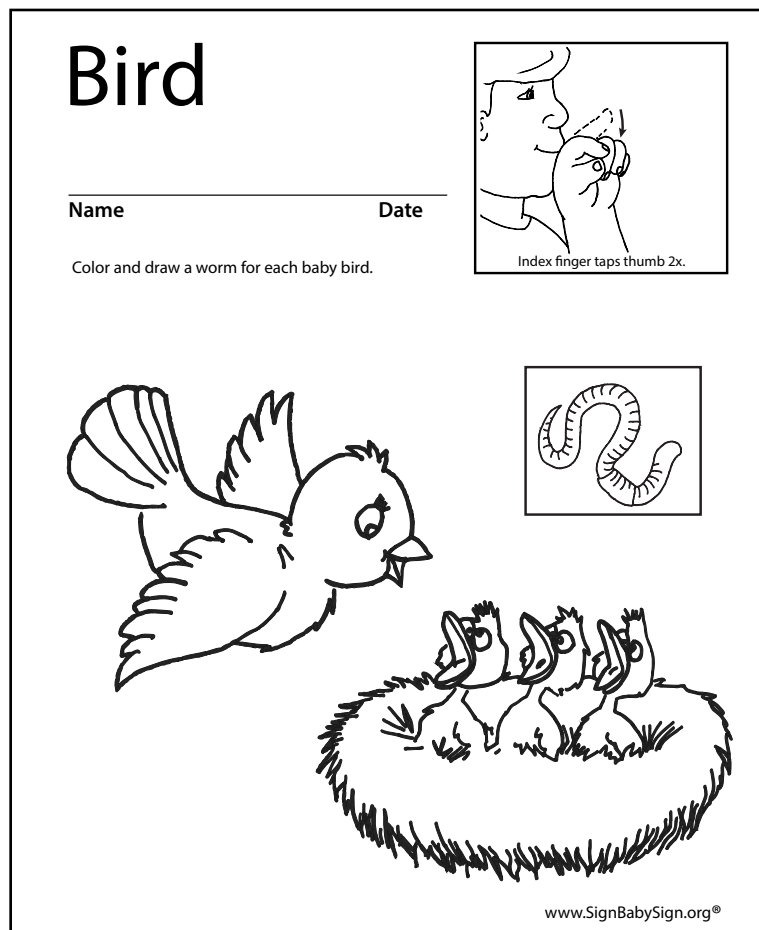
Color and draw a worm for each baby bird.

Craft: Make bird beaks to wear for game below.

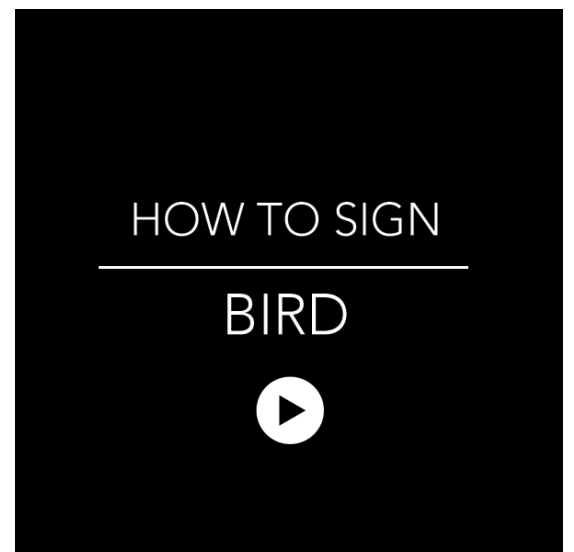
Game: Baby birds (kids) follow mom bird (adult).
