

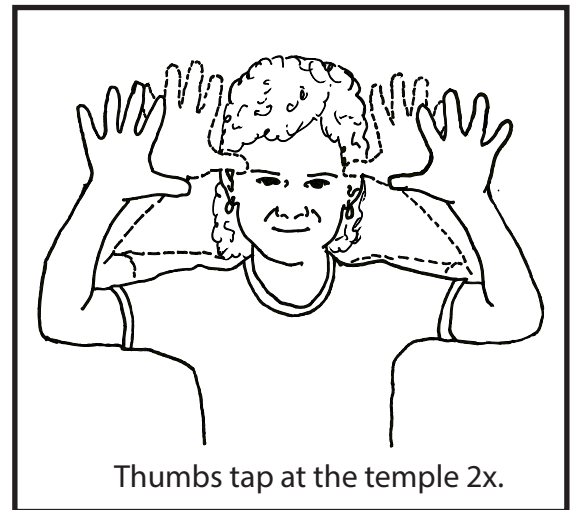
# Deer
