Topics: Celebrations, Holiday, Science

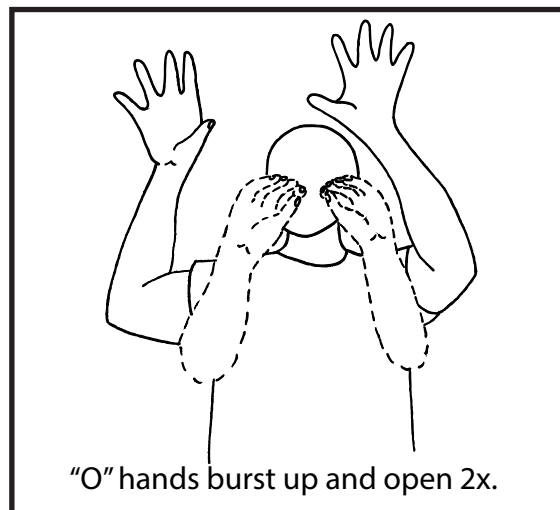
Materials: coloring utensils, string, paint, paper, jar, glow stick

Color and add colorful string on the fireworks.

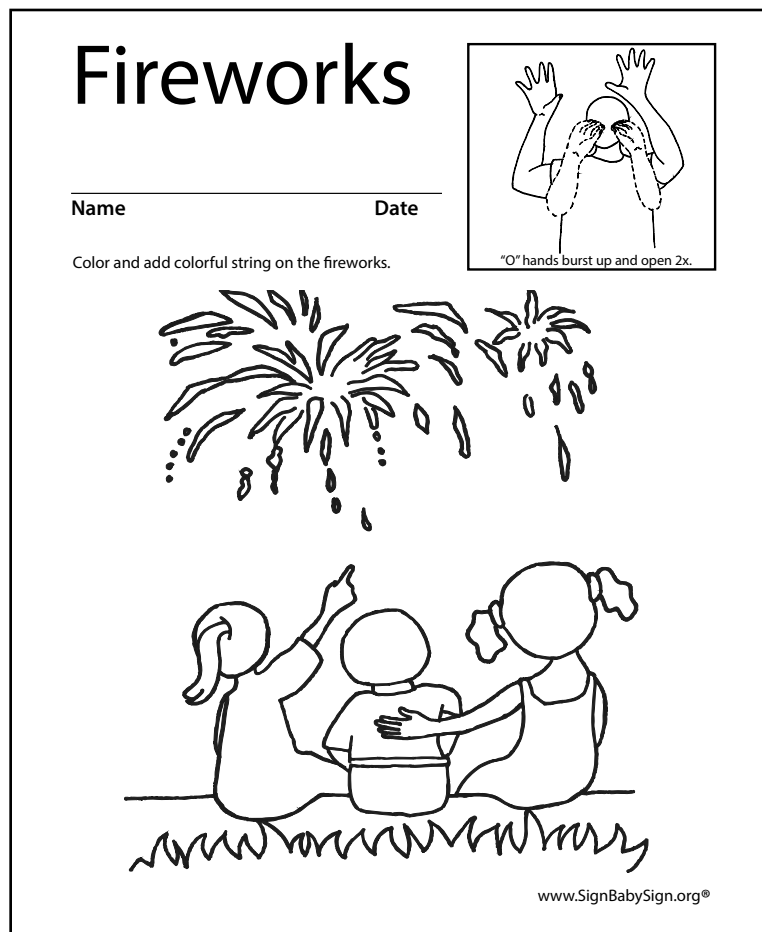
Craft: Splatter paint on paper or make a glow jar by cutting off the end of a glow stick, put in jar, and shake.

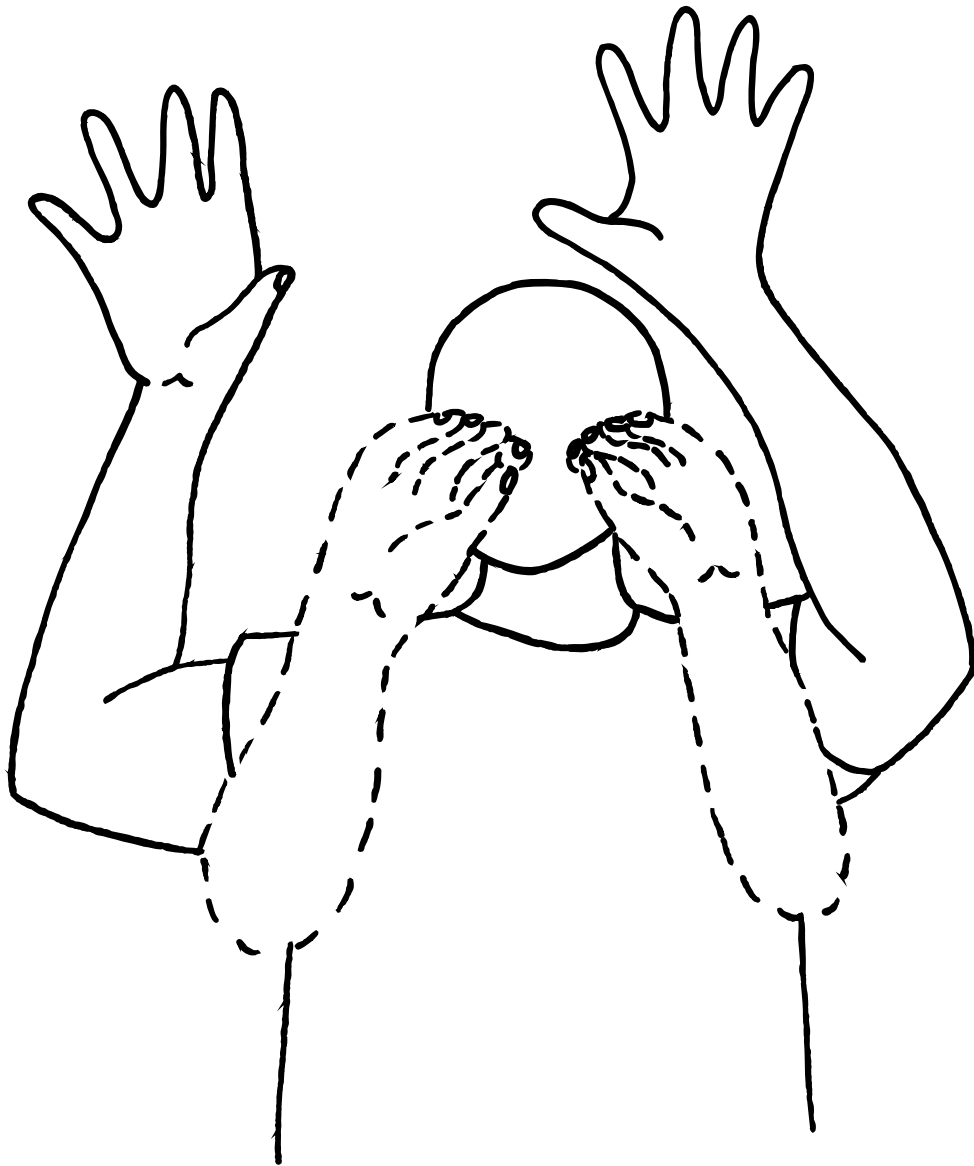

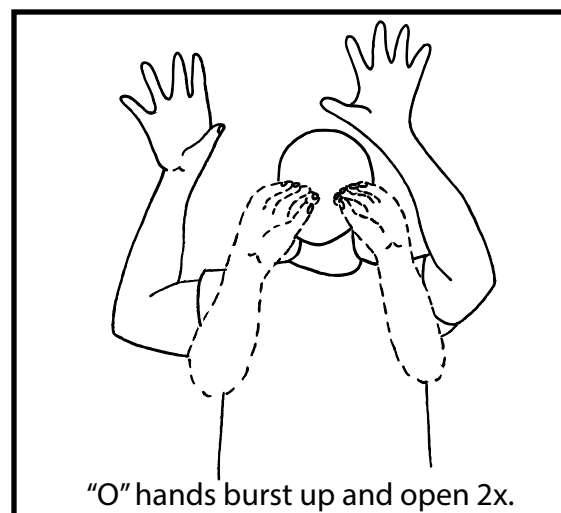

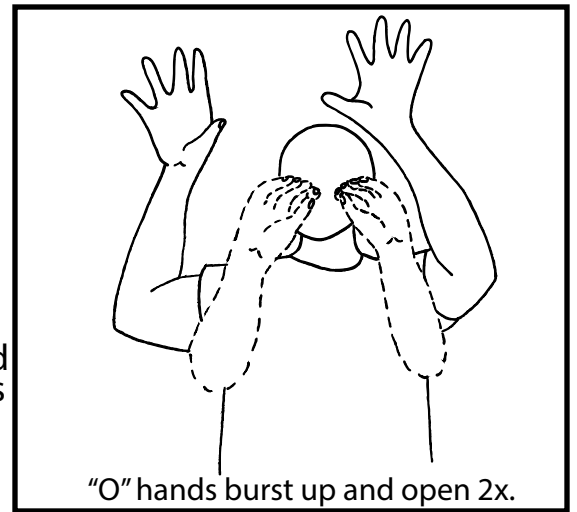
