Topics: Nationality, Holidays, Culture, July 4th, Flag Day

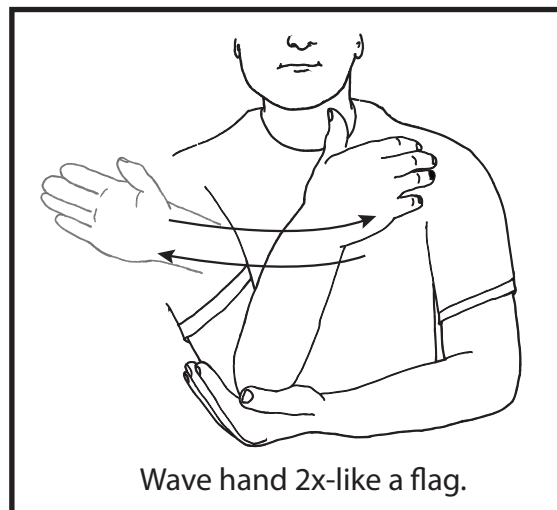
Materials: coloring utensils, star stickers, large cloth, paint

Idea: Teach children about the flag and its history. Eat red, white, and blue food.





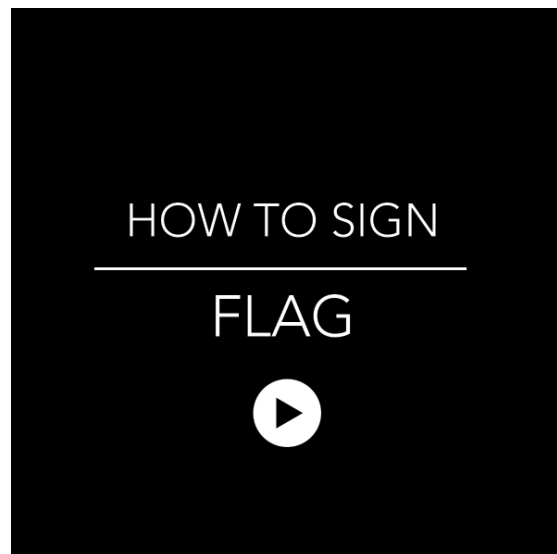

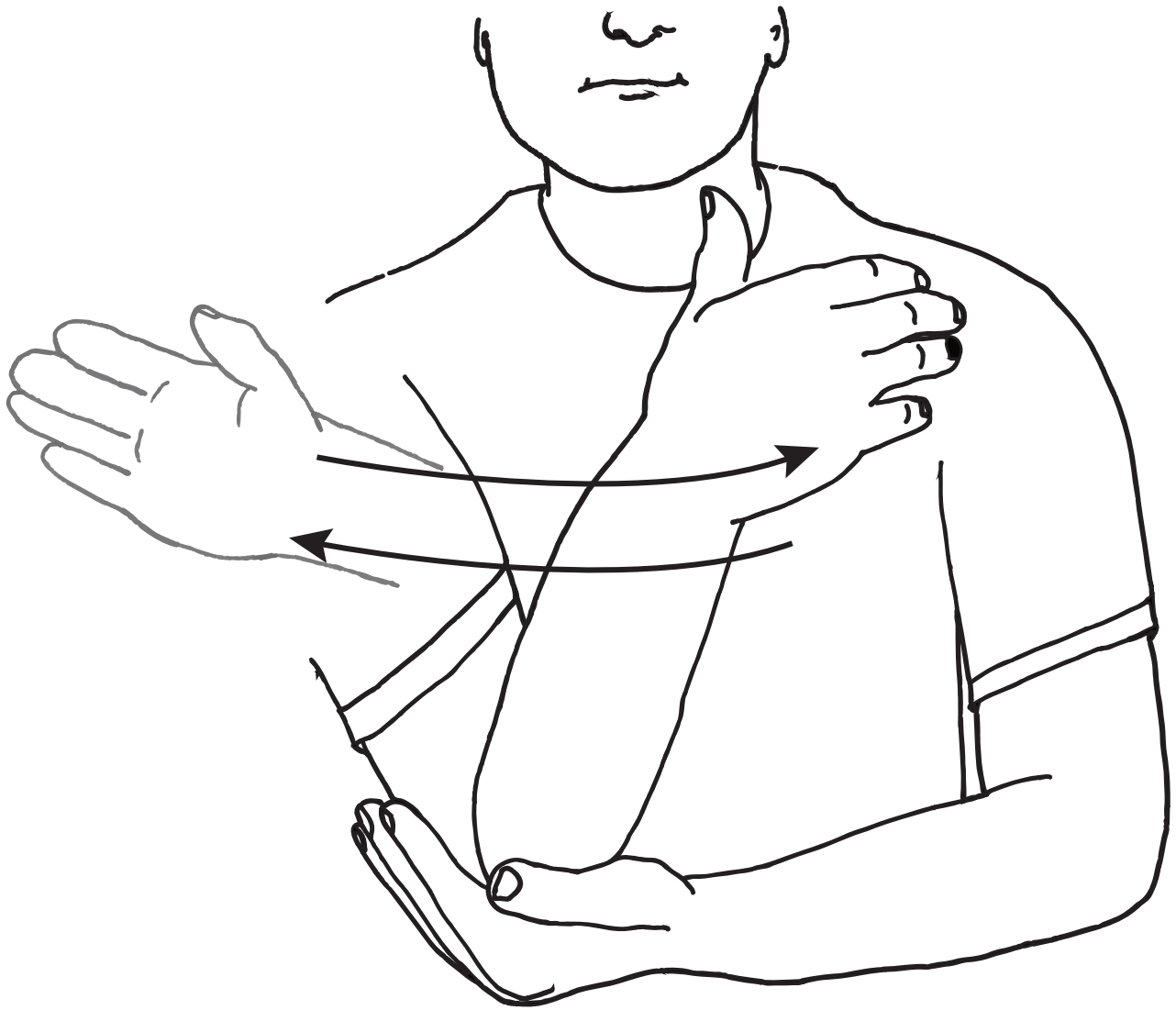
Wave hand 2x-like a flag.

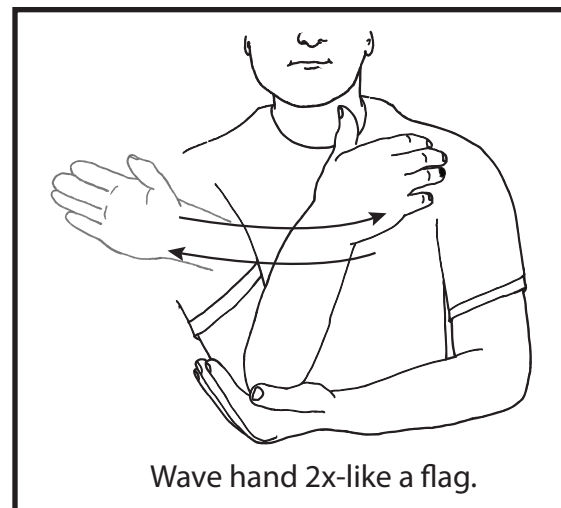

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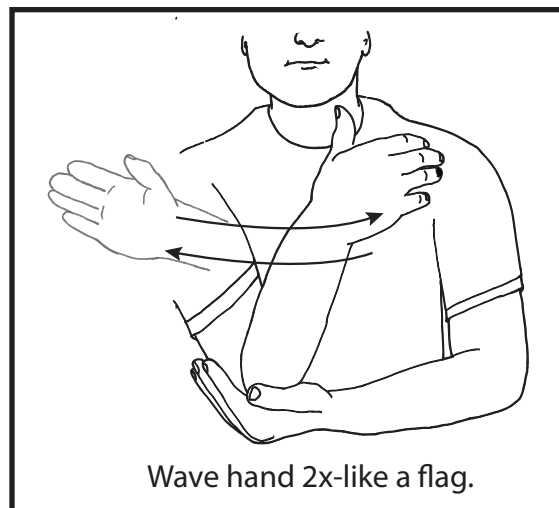

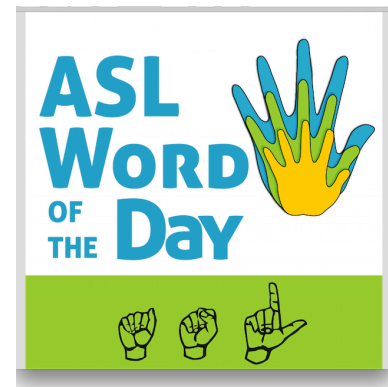
