

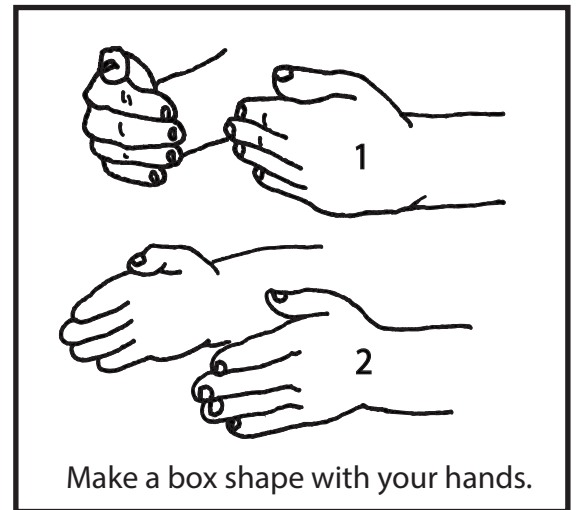

Materials: crayons, color tissue, wax paper



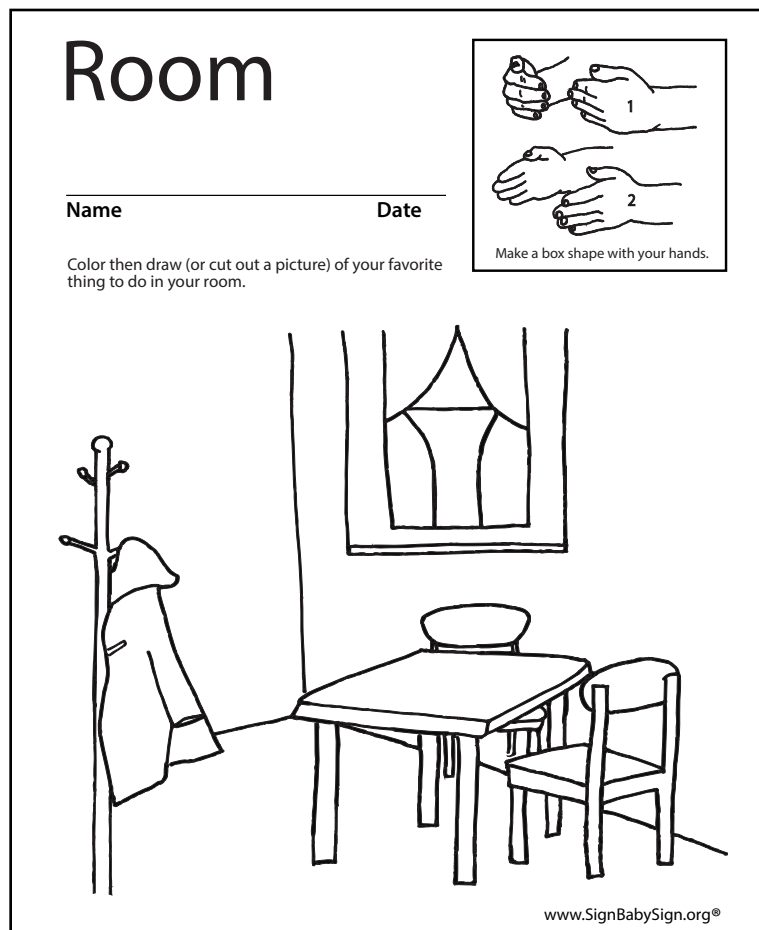
Color then draw (or cut out a picture) of your favorite thing to do in your room.

Craft: Make stain glass art for your windows. Use color tissue on wax paper.

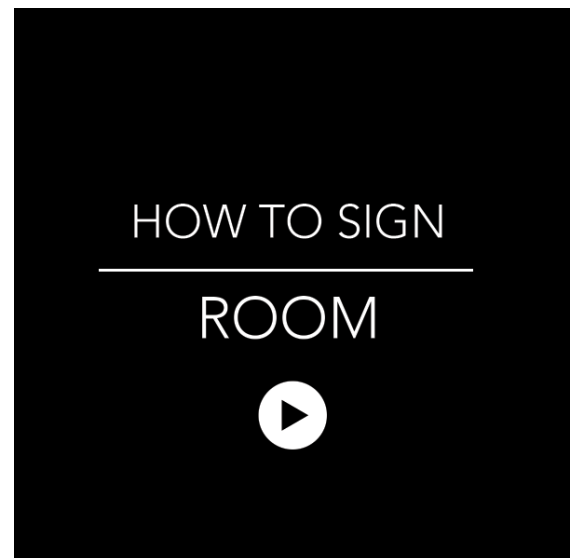
Game: Scavenger hunt for items in the room.

Idea: Next time you clean your room, give some of your toys to those in need.

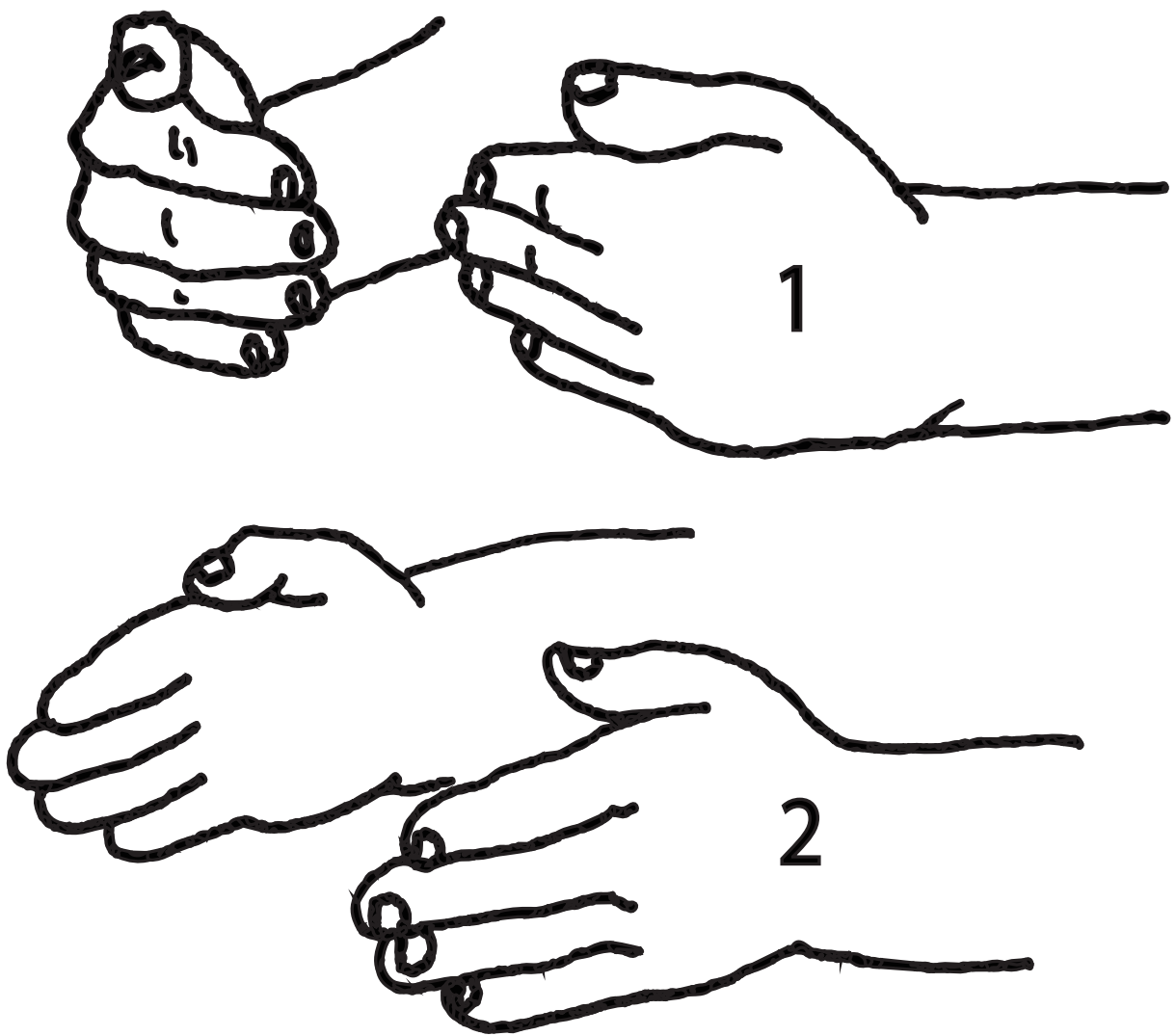
