Materials: Cardstock paper, glue




Color the picture and give to someone you love.

Craft: Make an "I Love You" hand. Trace your hand. Glue down the middle fingers to look like the picture.


Game: Play "Seven-Up" with "I love you" handshape.

Idea: Take turns sharing things you "love" about school, family, a pet, etc.






