
# My Book of Colors

Directions: Make a book of colors for each student.

- 1) Print and cut the front covers for each student (page 2).
- 2) Print and cut as many inside pages (page 3) needed for your students. Have the students write "I see" and then the color that is signed on that page. The students then color the bottom inch to match the signed color.
- 3) When the students are finished, staple one end of their pages to create their book.




#### Game Ideas:


Guess the signed color: Have a student come to the front of the classroom and sign a color. The other students open their color book to the signed color and hold it up.

Guess the spelled color: Fingerspell (or write) the color.

The other students open their color book to the signed color and hold it up.

Note: You can also reverse each of these games by having a student hold up a color from their book and have everyone else sign, or write down, the color.
