

Directions:

- 1. Fill out "voter Registration Application" and cut out the registration card.
- 2. Complete the "Think About It" pages. This exercise helps the students think about their options in each category before voting.
- 3. Cut the "Vote Now" pages and have the students place their votes in the ballot box (one vote in each category) *note: you can use a tissue box as a ballot box
