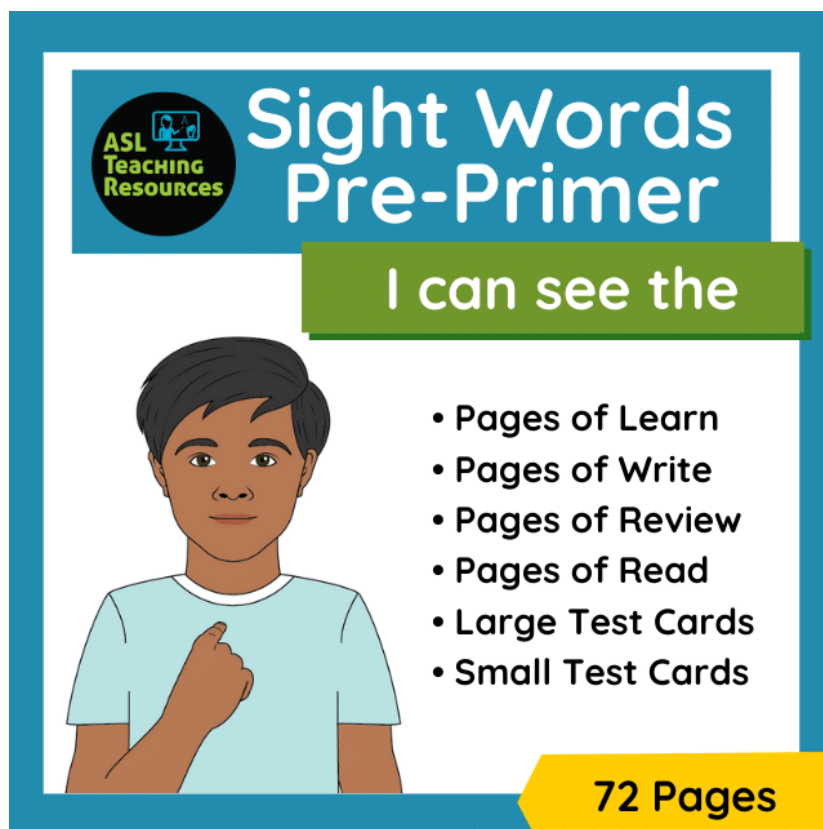

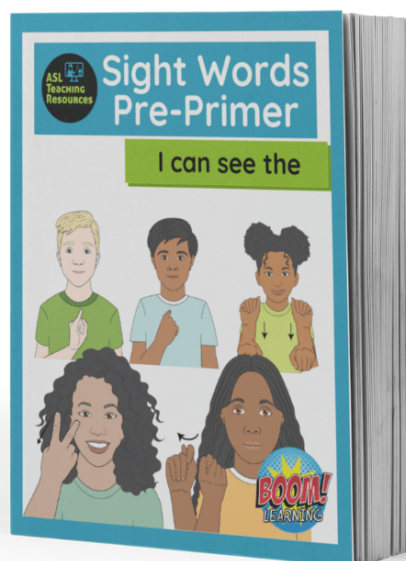

How to Teach Sight Words: (1) LEARN

These single sheets feature 6 different activities for students to begin becoming familiar with their new sight words. We recommend printing the colored version (dark or light skin) on cardstock and laminate for students to have ongoing practice.

1. Read the word
2. Sign the word.
3. Fingerspell the word
4. Write the word
5. Color the word
6. Find and circle the word

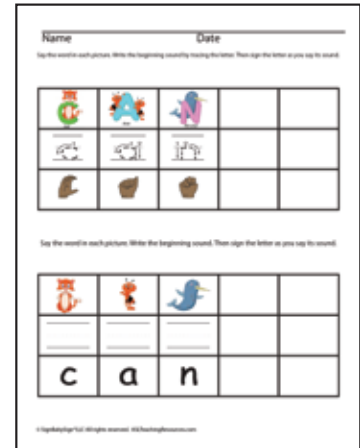

How to Teach Sight Words: (2) WRITE

Words are represented by an animal for each letter to support students needing practice with letter recognition. From there, students trace and then write their new sight words. We recommend printing the colored version (dark or light skin) on cardstock and laminate for students to have ongoing practice.

2. Write the word



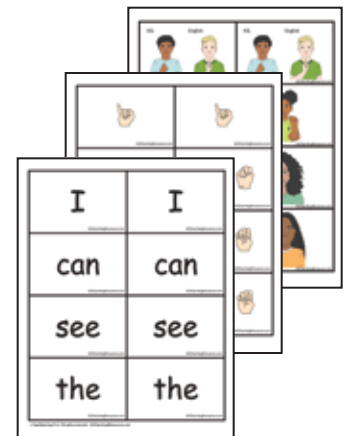

How to Teach Sight Words: (3) REVIEW

The Pre-Primer Sight Word Flashcards are designed to be used as a teaching tool, memory aid, games, assessing comprehension, and so much more to support students' knowledge of their new sight words.

Materials Needed: scissors, laminator, staple, dry erase markers or pencils, key rings, hole punch

1. Cut out all flashcards.
2. Arrange them in your preferred order.
3. Option 1) Laminate and then hole punch the upper left corner of the flashcards.
Option 2) Staple the flashcards together in the upper left corner.
4. Give to students to practice or assess their knowledge of their pre-primer sight words.
5. Use the sight word flashcards for games
 1. Memory game
 2. Match them all
 3. Post one on the wall for students to match with another flashcard
 4. Show a card for student to find more like it
 5. Fingerspell a word for them to find the word/sign
 6. Give them all a card for them to find a friend that matches theirs

How to Teach Sight Words: (4) READ

The Sight Word Books are designed for students to practice writing and reading the new sight words. Each word has its own book in the option of black and white, color with light or dark skin. Use all the sight word books for reinforcement of each word learned in the set. There are two ways this book can be used:

One)

1. Print out your ASL sight word book on paper.
2. Fold paper in half twice to create a book.

Or

Two)

1. Print out your ASL sight word book on paper.
2. Use Scissors to cut out each picture/page of the book.
3. Arrange the picture/pages in desired order and staple them together.

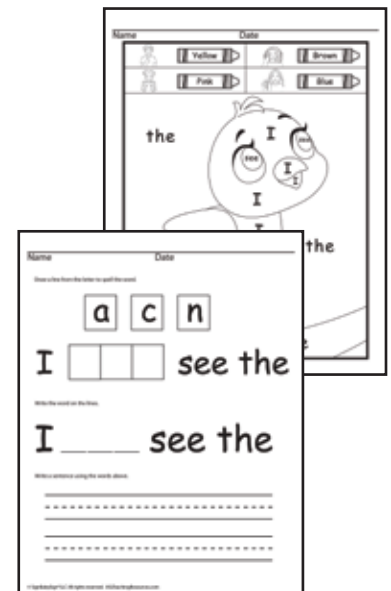
How to Teach Sight Words: (5) TEST
