


Level: Pre-K, K, 1, 2

Materials: Paper, marker, popsicle stick




Students follow directions on each worksheet.

Idea: Explore different ways we cry and why we cry.




My Emotions: Crying

- 3. Cut and glue the 4 words you chose into the boxes around the pictures.






