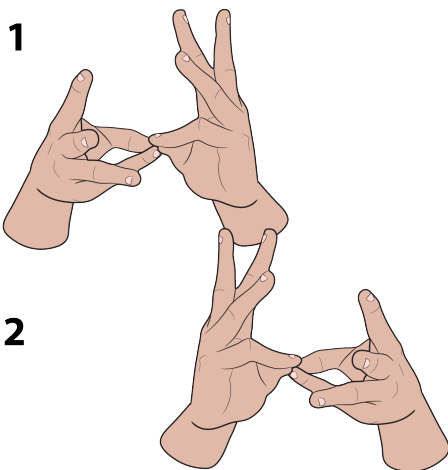

Snow

Level: PreK, K

Category: Weather Book

Topics: Weather, Science, Snow

Materials: Cotton balls, glue, construction paper, photo, bowl, blindfold, popsicle sticks, glitter, string

Use a cotton ball to follow the path. Then color and finish making the snowman. Draw a hat, nose, and eyes.

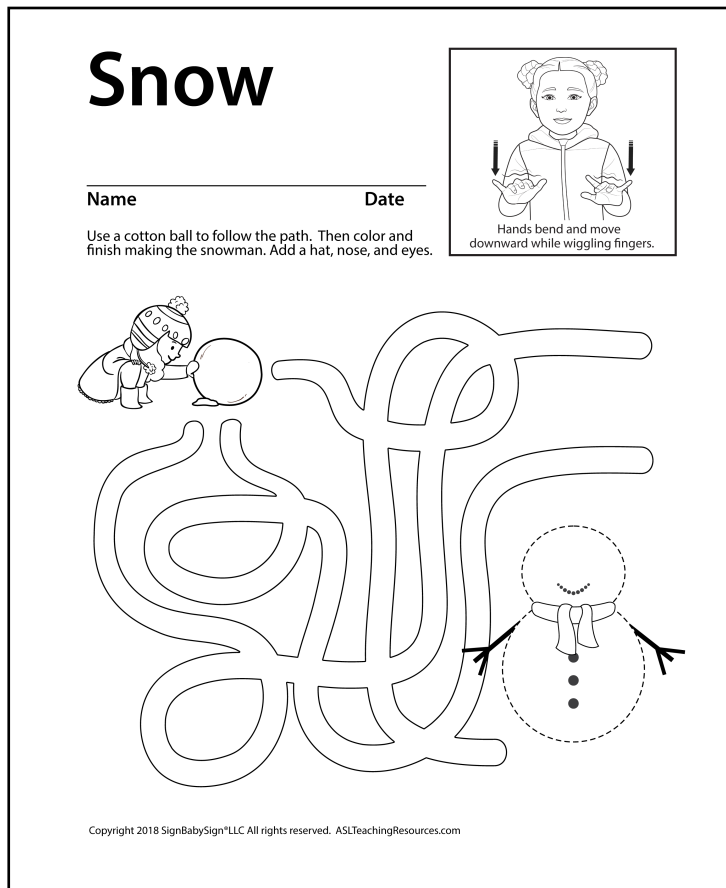
Craft: Color and glue a body on paper. Add the child's photo for the head. Glue cotton balls for a snowy scenery and around the face for an Eskimo coat look.

Game: Put cotton balls around the outside of a bowl. While blindfolded, try to scoop the "snow" with a spoon into the bowl. (No touching with hands.)

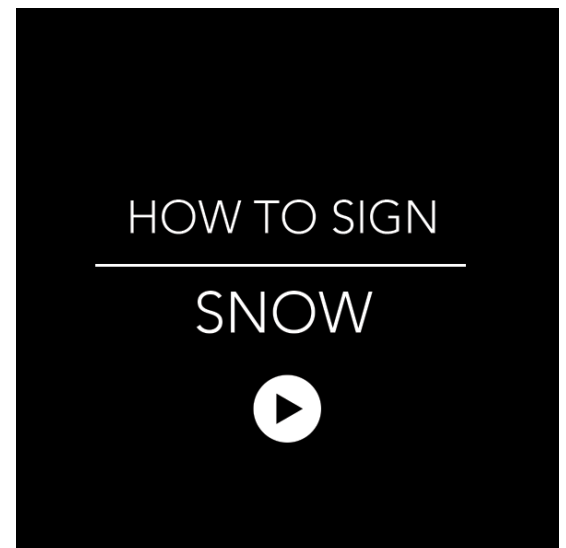
Idea: Make paper snowflakes or use popsicle sticks and glitter.

downward while wiggling fingers.

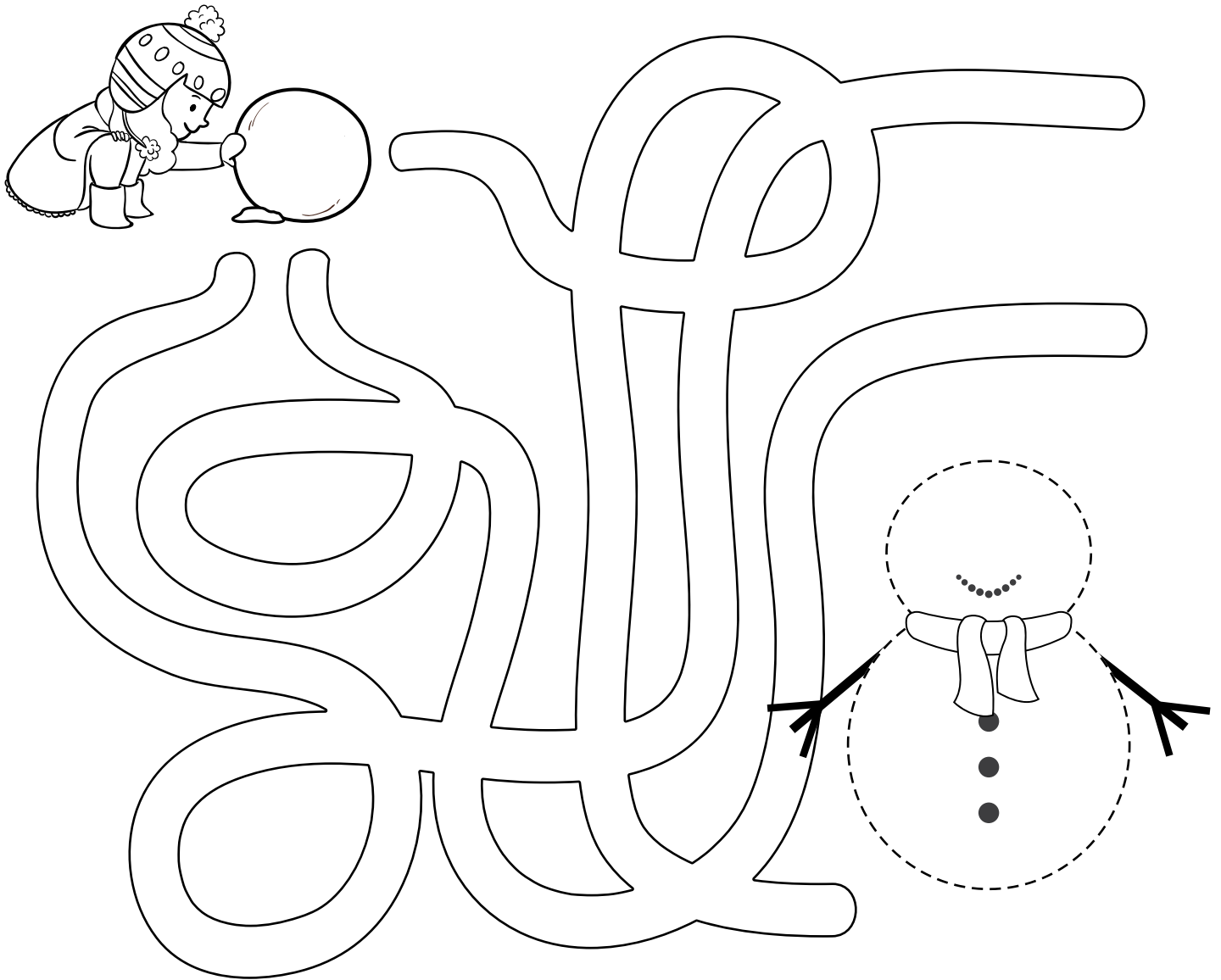
