



Directions: Students follow directions on each worksheet.




Craft: Decorate paper bags to look like rectangular characters for creative play with puppets.

Game: Make trays of rectangles, study then cover. How many can they remember?


Idea: Create rectangular object shadows with a flashlight. Children can identify and trace shadows.


