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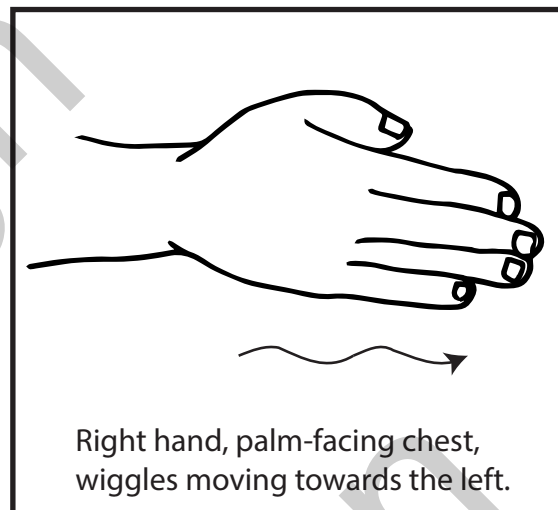
Fish

Materials: coloring utensils, paper clip, construction paper, stick, magnet goldfish



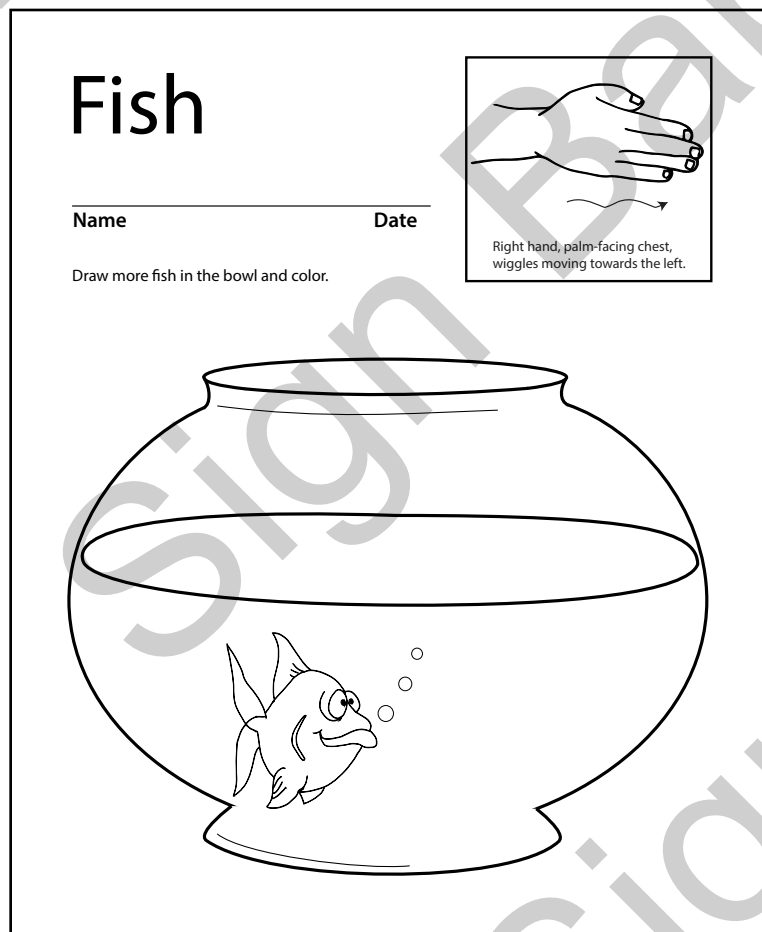
Draw more fish in the bowl and color.

Craft: Make fish and add paper clip for game.

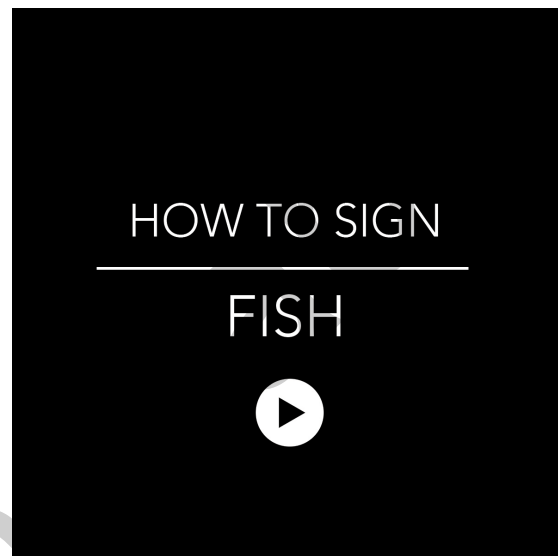
Game: Make a stick fishing pole with a magnet to let kids catch the fish they just made.

Idea: Have goldfish served in a fish bowl for snack time.

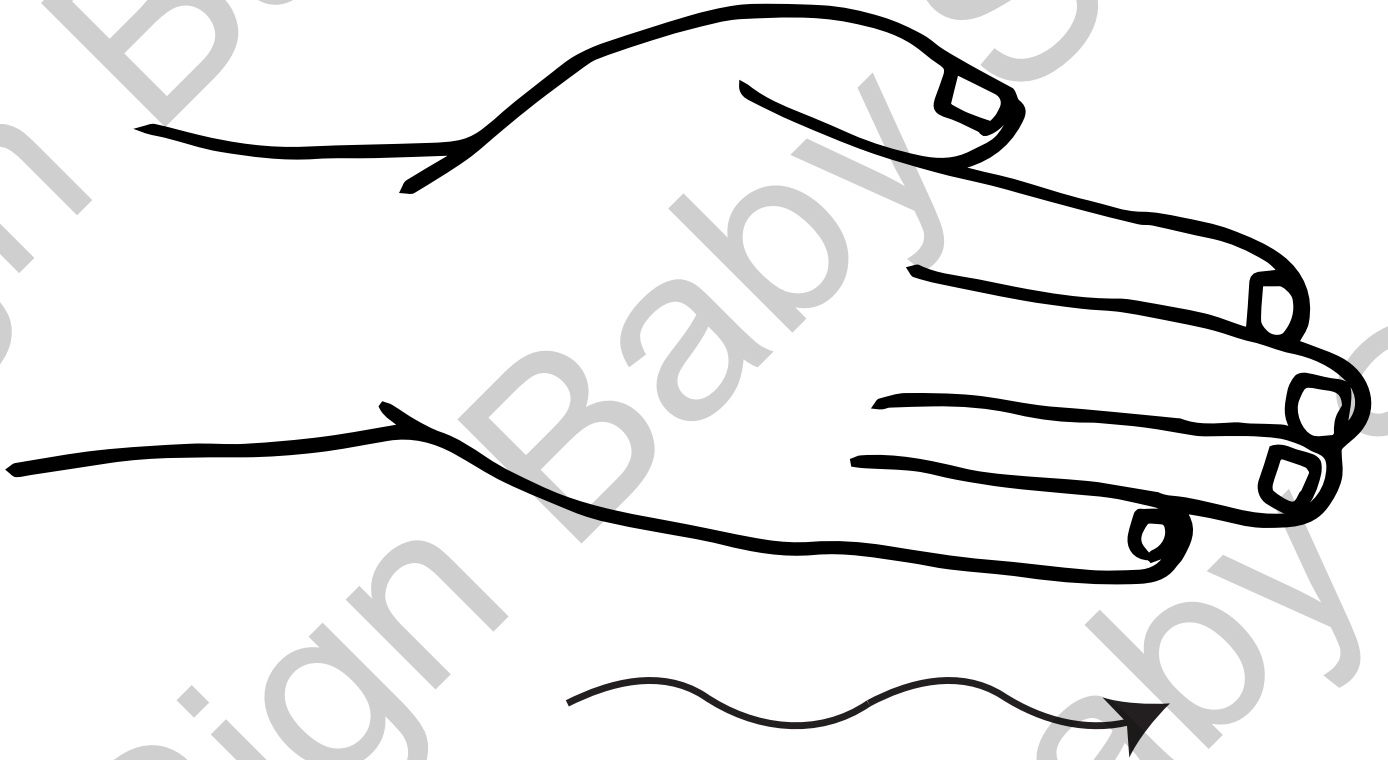

Topics: Clothing

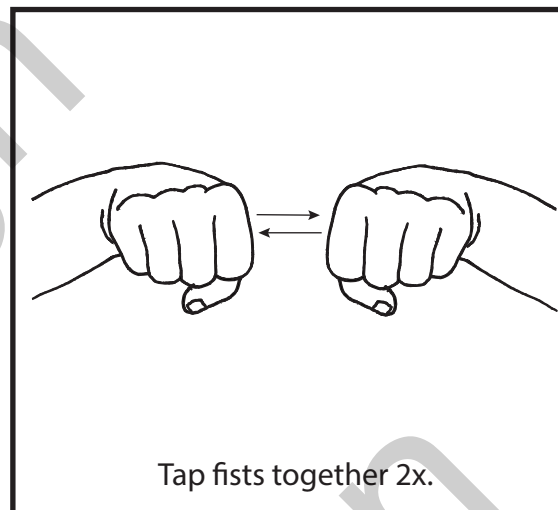
Materials: coloring utensils, scissors, plain paper, hole puncher, string, shoes

Design your own shoe.

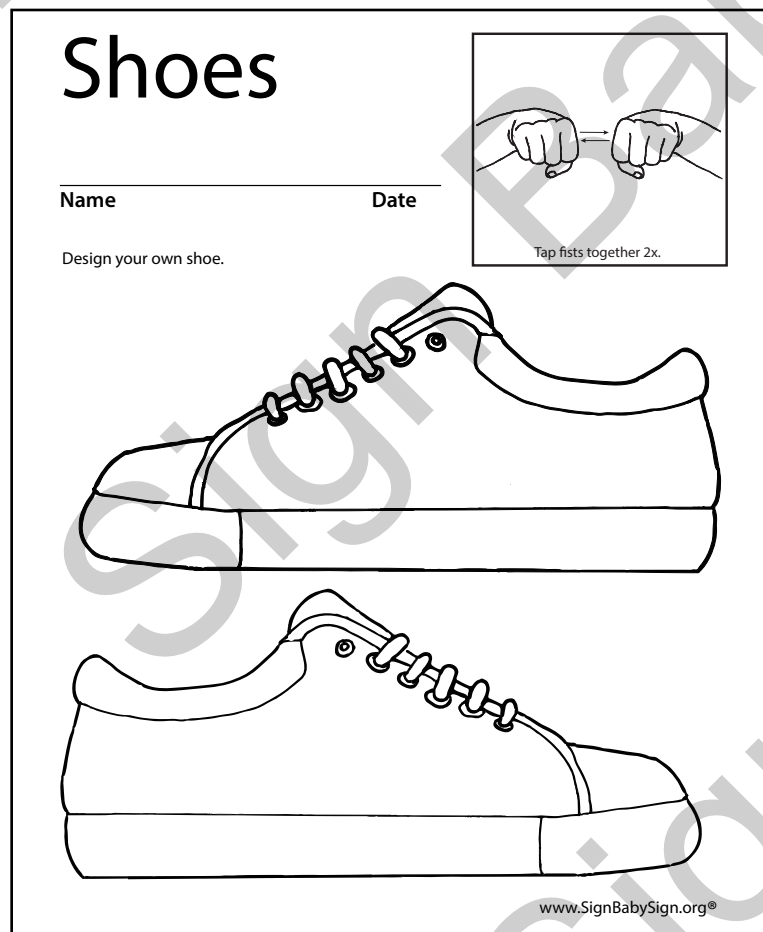

Game: Put one shoe from each child in a pile. Pick a shoe to have them guess whose it is. Also, you can have them race to get their shoe back on.

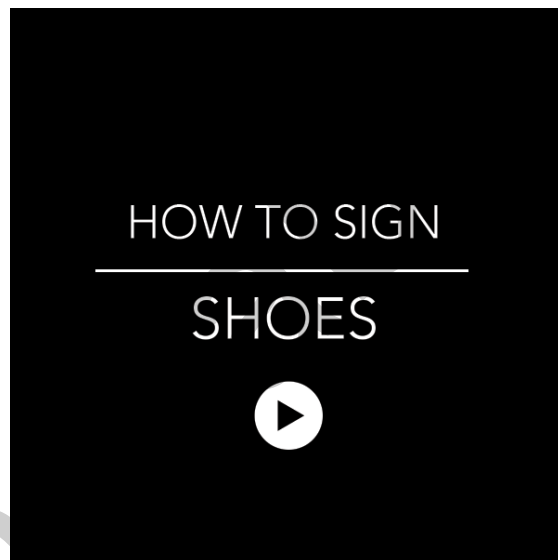
Idea: Cut out pictures of different kinds of shoes. Ask your children who would wear each one.



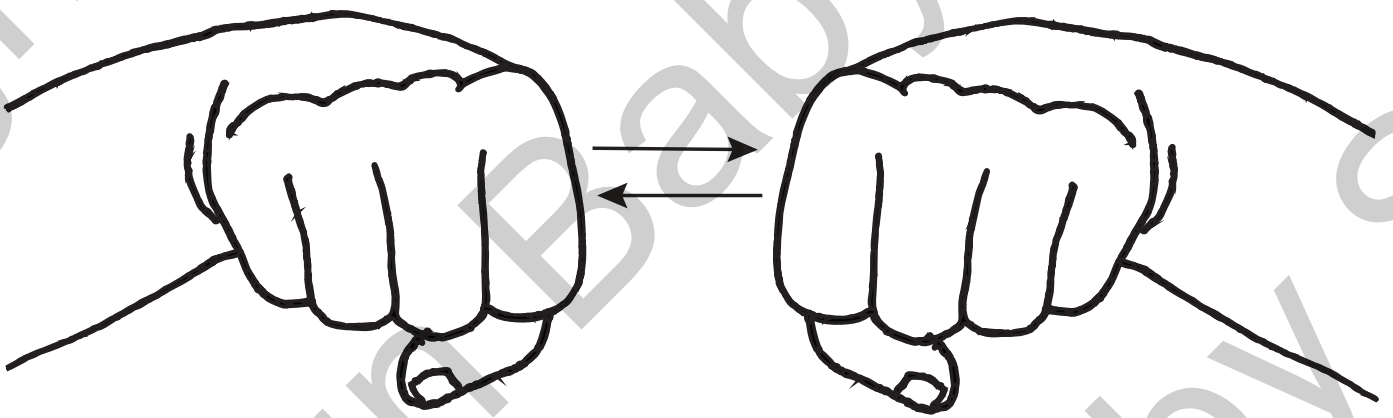
