

Craft: 1) Make a rain stick out of a paper towel roll.


2) Make a rain gauge out of a water bottle.

Game: Put raindrops on the wall. Blindfolded children add the cloud above the rain (like pin the tail on the donkey).







Connect the dots. Draw yourself holding the umbrella.
